THE WINEMAKING

The grapes were individually aged in new 300- & 500 liter French oak barrels for a period of eight months after which it was blended and bottled

WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS

Colour: Clear, luminous with green tints.

Bouquet: Aromas of citrus and flowers (violets) with spicy undertones of aniseed and cloves.

Taste: Youthful but full on taste with a complex mouth-feel and long aftertaste.

MATURATION POTENTIAL

Ready to enjoy now or can be matured for another two to three years if correctly cellared.

FOOD PAIRING

Excellent served with sushi, seafood, summer salads and hard cheeses.
